According with NATO's strategic vision, and European Union Strategic Compass, we live in an era of strategic competition and complex security threats. We see conflicts, military build-ups and aggressions, and sources of instability increasing in our neighbourhood and beyond, leading to severe humanitarian suffering and displacement. Hybrid threats grow both in frequency and impact, promoting a strong cooperation between main cyberspace security stakeholders, seeking to stimulate synergies and foster Allied Nations collaborative efforts, in order to ensure the development, acquisition and maintenance of the necessary security capabilities.

The **Cyberspace Security Cooperation Conference - "SECURING EURO-ATLANTIC CYBERSPACE LANDSCAPE"** will enhance the EU's capacity as an international cyberspace security actor, contribute to the protection of EU citizens and maximise the effectiveness of defence spending, taking advantage of the new defence investment opportunities created recently by both the EU and NATO. It will represent an unusual opportunity to discuss new ideas: from harmonising requirements to delivering operational capabilities; from research and innovation to transformation; from education, training and exercises to maintenance and support for operations, adopting new and improved cyber defence and security policies, reinforcing the EU-NATO complementarity of efforts on the field of cyberspace security.

The Cyber PESCO Projects Cluster envisage jointly developing new and innovative cyber capabilities with better coordination of efforts and collaboration, in a domain where private ecosystems keep a leading edge, while bringing together the combined strengths of public and private investment.

This Conference is intended to reinforce the NATO-EU complementarity of efforts on the field of Cyber Security and Cyber Defence. In line with the recent NATO-EU Joint Declaration, this event also seeks to enhance the implementation of the common set of proposals formulated at the NATO Warsaw Summit, creating a multidimensional framework and a Synergetic Approach (Pooling & Sharing), namely on the areas of Cyber Innovation, Operations, Education, Training and Exercises.

The conference themes and highlights will be discussed by an audience of PESCO and EDF project coordinators, policymakers, decision-makers, heads of cyber units, from Military, Academia and the Industry, senior officials coming from international organizations, as well as other interested parties.

The conference **will take place on 25th May 2023, starting at 09h30, in the Hotel TIVOLI Oriente, Lisbon.**
