



VII Atlantic Centre Seminar Held at the Navy Museum – Climate Change and Security Challenges in the Atlantic

27 November 2025

On October 30, 2025, the Atlantic Centre held its VII Seminar, entitled “Climate Change and Security Challenges in the Atlantic” at the Navy Museum in Lisbon. The event brought together experts, decision-makers and international partners to discuss the impacts of climate change and extreme weather events on coastal and islands communities.

The initiative reinforced climate change not only as an environmental issue, but also as a security challenge that requires collective action among Atlantic countries.

During the event, the 5th report coordinated by the Atlantic Centre, “Climate Change and Security Challenges in the Atlantic”, was presented, which analysed the multiple dimensions of climate risks and threats and their intersections with critical areas such as international law, maritime security, food security, humanitarian response and disaster risk management.

The Atlantic Centre underlines that addressing the climate crisis is an environmental and security strategic priority, essential to ensuring a safe, stable and prosperous Atlantic.
