Summary

The Gulf of Guinea has become a hotspot for maritime piracy, generating a considerable impact regionally and internationally. In recent years, multiple international partners and donors have engaged with regional actors, seeking to minimize the negative impacts of these activities on maritime security.

The UNODC report "Pirates of the Niger Delta: between brown and blue waters", developed with the support of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark, expands existing knowledge on the topic and provides a valuable tool to enhance the efficiency of regional and national policies to better target the sources of piracy and armed robbery in this region.

This seminar aims to raise awareness on the current context and to disseminate the important findings of this work, in line with the Atlantic Centre's mission to promote peace and security in the Atlantic.
