Atlantic Centre (AC) represented at the 12th edition of "The Atlantic Dialogues" in Morocco

The Atlantic Dialogues was the meeting point for Atlantic leaders, businesspeople, academics, opinion makers and civil society actors from around 90 countries, who gathered as part of the annual high-level international conference from 14 to 16 December in Morocco.

Under the theme "A more assertive Atlantic: what it means for the world", this event, promoted by the Policy Centre for the New South, brings together an influential group of leaders to reflect on improving public, economic, social and security policies in Morocco and Africa as a whole.

The Atlantic Centre's Coordinator, Rear Admiral Nuno de Noronha Bragança, was part of the panel of speakers at the conference debating the 10th edition of the Atlantic Currents report, published annually by the Policy Centre for the New South.

The report under discussion, which proposes a strategic vision of Atlantic affairs, includes a number of points aligned with the lines of action defined for the Atlantic Centre, such as sustainable energy, the international economy, geopolitics, security, and cooperation.

A forum for promoting dialogue and seeking innovative solutions, The Atlantic Dialogues aims to share points of view from North to South in an open, transparent, and informal way, with the aim of creating points of balance between the various participating countries.
