Mission of the Atlantic Centre to Brasília

The Atlantic Centre (AC) traveled to Brasília, Brazil, a signatory country of the AC, from March 17 to 20.

The delegation, composed of the AC Coordinator, Rear Admiral Nuno de Noronha Bragança, and Captain Luis da Costa Cabral, held working meetings with various entities, including the Ministries of Defense, Foreign Affairs, and Fisheries, the Portuguese Embassy in Brasília, as well as representatives from the Centre for Sovereignty and Climate and the University of Brasília. The visit also included participation in a workshop at the Higher School of Defense (ESD).

This mission provided an opportunity to present the work developed by the AC, outline planned activities for 2025, and highlight its growth trajectory, which has strengthened the consolidation of an Atlantic community of interest. By the end of 2024, the AC had 24 member states and began 2025 with 25 member states.
