



Atlantic Centre Participates in the “Security Challenges in the Atlantic and Beyond” Panel at the EU-Brazil Workshop on Maritime Security

On 2 and 3 of December 2025, the Atlantic Centre took part in the EU-Brazil Workshop on Maritime Security, held at Centro Cultural de Belém, in Lisbon, Portugal, organised by The European External Action Service (EEAS).

The Atlantic Centre's Deputy Coordinator, Navy Captain Luís Paulo dos Santos Fernandes, participated in the panel "Security Challenges in the Atlantic and Beyond: Coordination and Complementarity", sharing the stage with Mr. Tiago Lemos, Policy Officer Maritime Security Division, EEAS and Navy Captain Marcio Braga de Souza, Brazil's Naval Attaché to Portugal, in a debate moderated by Mr. Alessandro Rossi, Policy Officer Regional Affairs – Security and AMERICAS at EEAS.

This panel explored the concrete security challenges facing the Atlantic and discussed how coordination between the European Union and Brazil, and partner organisations could be strengthened. It also provided an opportunity to reflect on lessons emerging from ongoing operations and existing cooperation frameworks.
