



Visit to the Dominican Republic

1 October 2025

Between 20 and 24 September, the Atlantic Centre — represented by its Coordinator, Rear Admiral Nuno de Noronha Bragança, and its Deputy Coordinator, Luís Costa Cabral — had the opportunity to visit the Dominican Republic for a series of high-level meetings with local authorities.

During the visit, the Atlantic Centre took part in working meetings with the Minister of Defence, General Fernández Onofre; Vice Minister Francisco Caraballo of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; representatives of the Ministry of Environment and Natural Resources; Vice Admiral Juan Crisóstomo, Commander-in-Chief of the Dominican Republic Navy; as well as senior representatives of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Armed Forces, among others.
