



Atlantic Centre Mission to Cabo Verde Strengthens Maritime Security Cooperation

Between 23 and 26 of February, the Atlantic Centre had the opportunity to visit Cabo Verde, a founding member of the Atlantic Centre deeply committed to strengthening maritime security in the Atlantic. The visit included a series of high-level meetings with the National Defence Director, the Ministry for Foreign Affairs, the Director of the Multinational Maritime Coordination Center (MMCC) Zone G, as well as representatives from the European Union, Portuguese, and Brazilian Delegations in Praia. These discussions provided an important opportunity to reinforce institutional ties, explore areas of mutual interest, and exchange perspectives on the most pressing regional and global challenges related to maritime safety and security. During the same period, the Atlantic Centre also participated in the SEACOP VI Regional Meeting, an initiative that brings together diverse points of view to consolidate strong and lasting Atlantic partnerships committed to improving security and promoting the sustainable well-being of our Atlantic Ocean.
