Atlantic Centre attends 7th “Atlantic Strategy Group - North and South in a Changing Atlantic”

The Atlantic Centre, represented by its coordinator, Rear Admiral Nuno de Noronha Bragança, attended the 7th edition of the Atlantic Strategy Group organised by the Policy Center for the New South and the German Marshall Fund United States on 23 and 24 October in Rabat.

The panel discussion entitled "A new Atlantic system? Implications for policy and governance", moderated by Ian Lesser, Vice President of the German Marshall Fund of the United States, included the participation of Rear Admiral Nuno de Noronha Bragança, who shared the panel with Ambassador Jessica Lappen, coordinator of the American Atlantic Cooperation initiative, and Ambassador Tarik Iziraren, representative of the Africa States Process initiative. Remotely, this panel also included the participation of Ambassador Nezha Alaoui M'hammdi, representing the Policy Center for the New South (PCNS).

On this occasion, the Atlantic's future challenges were discussed, and the related policies analysed in the context of a changed and more risk-prone geopolitical and geo-economic scenario.
