The Atlantic Centre's Coordinator attends the inauguration of the Multinational Maritime Coordination Centre

On 31 January 2024, the Atlantic Centre Coordinator, Rear Admiral Nuno de Noronha Bragança, travelled to the city of Praia in Cape Verde to attend the inauguration of the headquarters of the Multinational Maritime Coordination Centre of the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS) in zone G, at a ceremony attended by senior figures from the Cape Verdean government, European Union representatives and other international bodies.
